Subject: Part VII Application by Canadian Association of Internet Providers Pursuant to the *CRTC Telecommunications Rules Of Procedure and Sections 7, 24, 25, 27, 32, 36 and 62 of the Telecommunications Act Requesting Certain Orders Directing Bell Canada to Cease and Desist from "Throttling" its Wholesale ADSL Access Services - Answer*

1. Bell Canada (or the Company) hereby provides its Answer to an Application dated 3 April 2008, made by the Canadian Association of Internet Providers (CAIP) pursuant to sections 7, 24, 25, 27, 32, 36 and 62 of the *Telecommunications Act* and Part VII of the *CRTC Telecommunications Rules of Procedure* requesting that the Commission issue an order on an expedited basis directing Bell Canada to immediately cease and desist from "throttling" wholesale ADSL services and in particular, the wholesale service known as Gateway Access Service (GAS).

2. The failure by the Company to respond to any comment or allegation by CAIP should not be taken as concurrence with that comment or allegation, where such concurrence would be contrary to the interests of the Company in this proceeding.
